

A bibliography of research on the geography of South Australia: 2002-2007

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This bibliography lists research articles published from 2002 to 2007, and postgraduate theses (provided they are lodged in a library), that examine aspects of the physical and human geography of South Australia. It does not include books, monographs or working papers.

Items have been selected for inclusion on the basis of their contribution to an understanding of South Australian environments, regions and places; society-environment relationships; and the role of place. Some items for earlier years missed in the previous bibliography for 2002-2005 are also included.

The bibliography is based on searches of the electronic bibliographic databases **GeoBase, Web of Science, Informit and Libraries Australia**, and the authors come from a variety of disciplines.

The author would be grateful to be advised of any significant omissions as no bibliography can ever be complete. The bibliography will be continued as an occasional account of research in subsequent issues of this journal.
